Confessions of a Wine-fuelled Entrepreneur - presented by Cecillia Muldoon

This will be a presentation with a difference and not one to be missed!

Cecillia has founded VeriVin - a small innovative start-up company which is developing a unique non-invasive wine analyser – in her words "to know what's in the bottle without taking the cork out"

She has had a very unusual career path. Despite the Irish name she is from Mexico. She will tell us the story of how she has travelled from being an aspiring ballerina to doing a doctorate in quantum physics to starting up VeriVin. Along the way she was President of the Oxford University Wine Circle and a member of the University Blind Tasting Team.

She will share with us some of the wines that have inspired her journey – and try and convince us (very briefly she promises) that quantum physics is not rocket science. And the wines will be good – she asked for a bigger budget for the wines! It should be fascinating.
